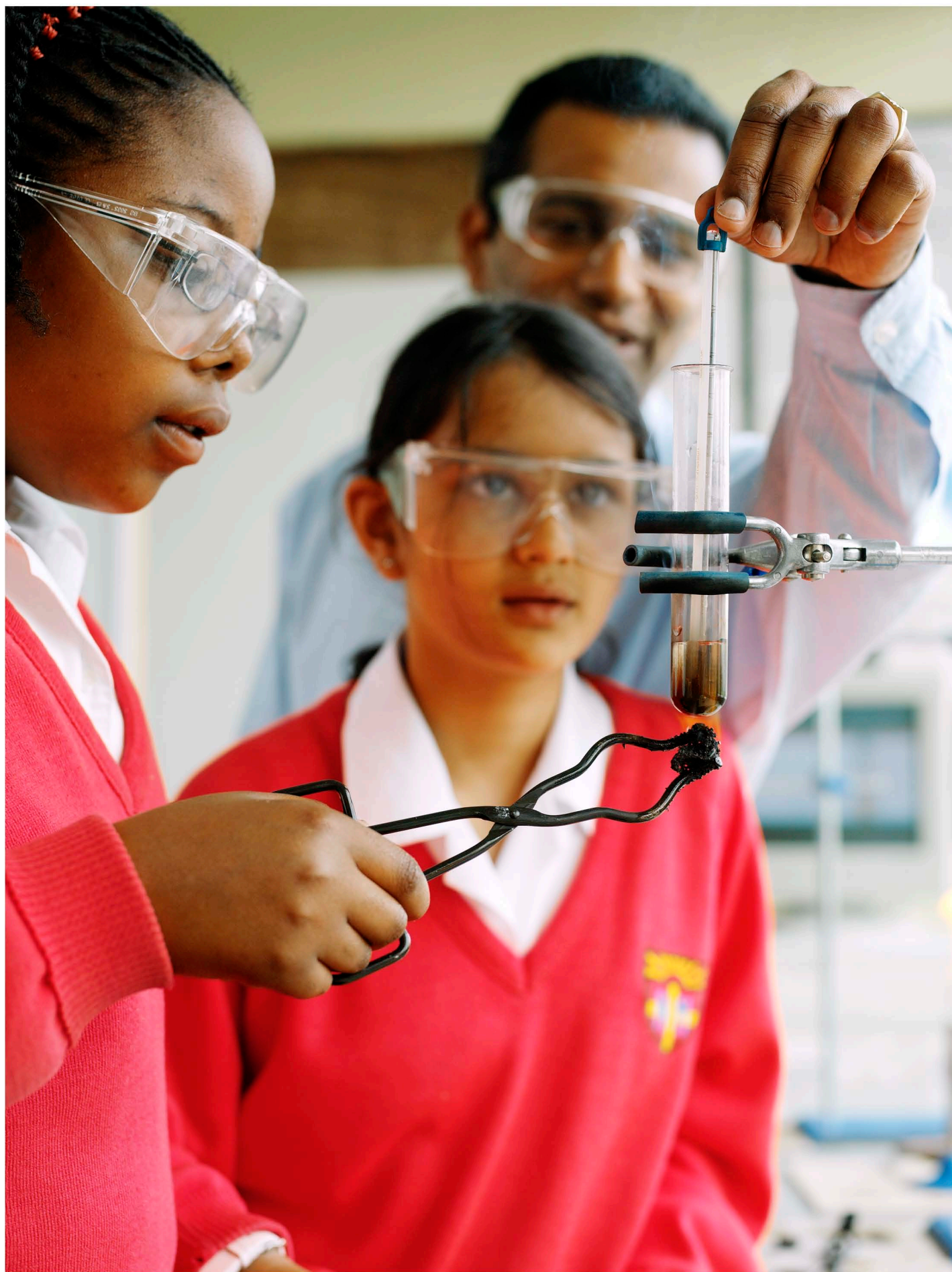












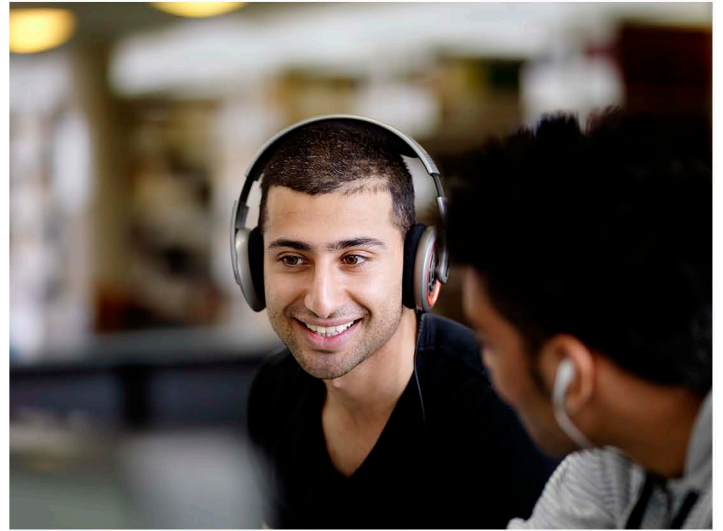




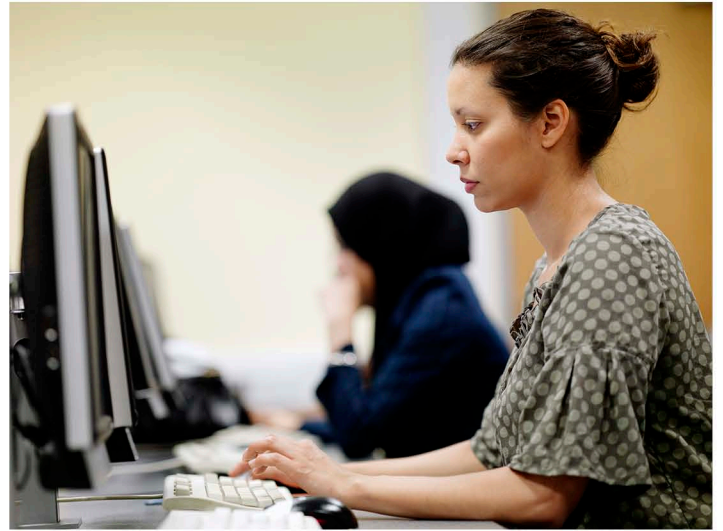
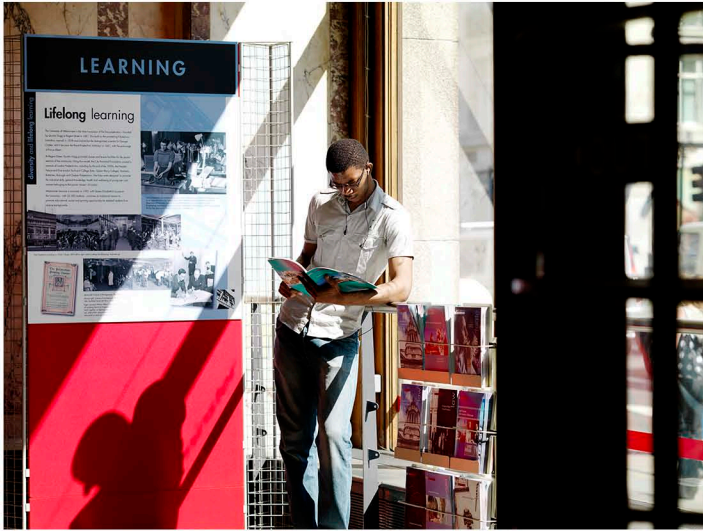




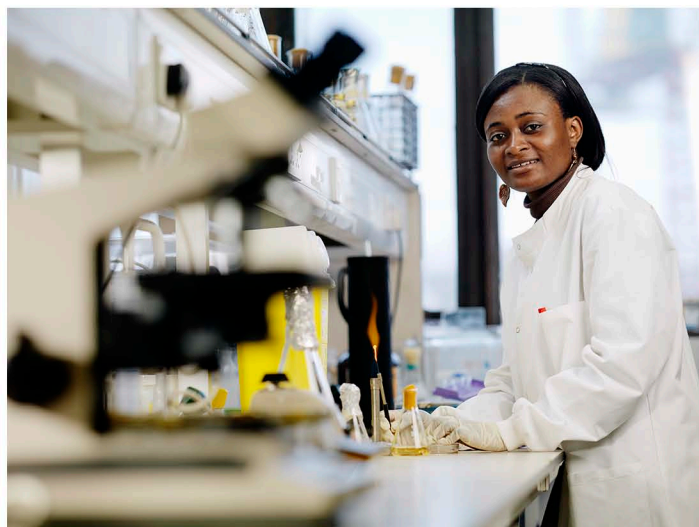
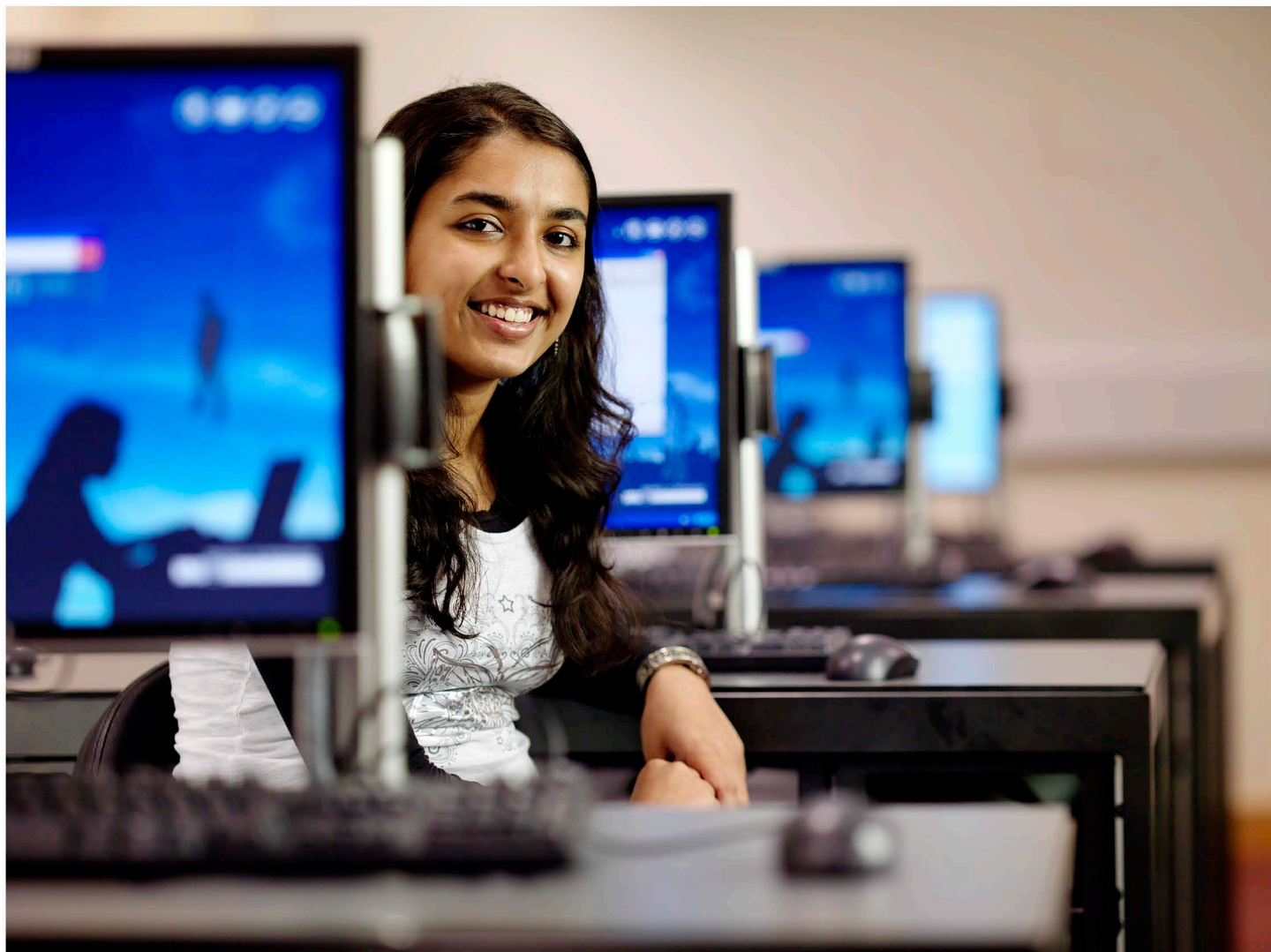








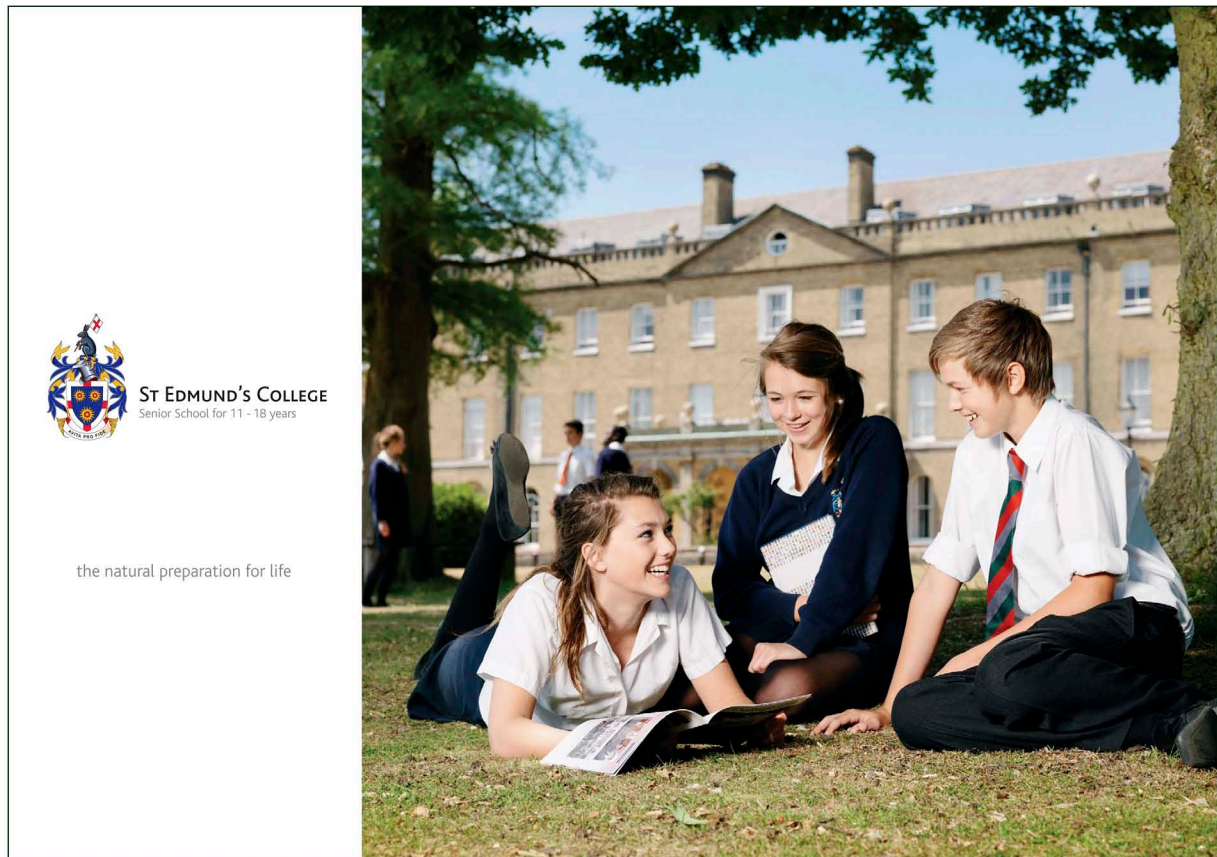
















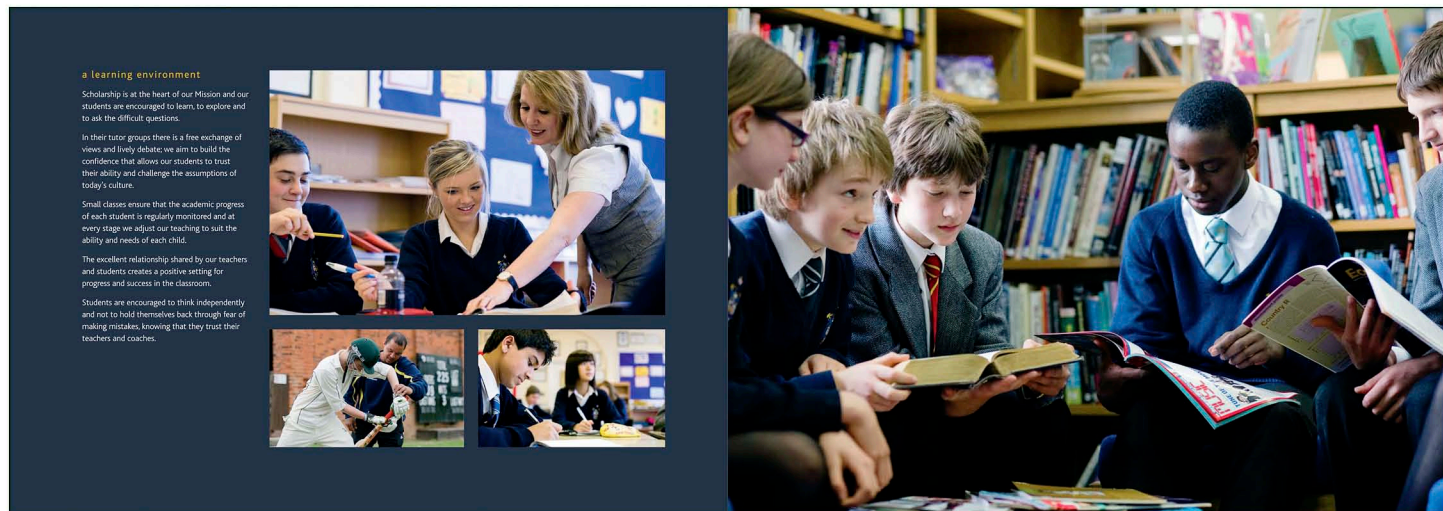
**Cygnets nursery - a home from home**

Small classes ensure that the academic progress of each student is regularly monitored and at every stage we adjust our teaching to suit the ability and needs of each child.

Students are encouraged to think independently and not to hold themselves back through fear of making mistakes, knowing that they trust their teachers and coaches.

We believe that a fully rounded education is not complete without an awareness and appreciation of culture and the arts.

Self-expression through creation develops practical skills as well as imagination and mental dexterity.

Students are introduced to a variety of two- and three-dimensional work through our Fine Art, Design Technology, Ceramics and Textile studios.

At St Edmund's the performing arts take many forms: from full-scale College musical productions to smaller scale student-directed dramas. The emphasis is always on our students being fully involved in all aspects of the productions.
